CAS 2020

The CAS (Coastal Associated Sport) is an after-school sporting program run by the ACC (*Associated & Catholic Colleges of WA*). CAS is a friendly, yet competitive sporting program, which enables students to engage with their friends through sport, building healthy relationships and self-management skills.

The 2020 Summer CAS sporting competition begins on **Tuesday 18 February for Senior Secondary students (Years 10-12) and Wednesday 19 February for Lower Secondary students (Years 8-9. Year 7's may trial for Junior teams)**. Students meet at the College Sport Centre at the beginning of lunch for away games and by 3.20pm for home games to change into their Physical Education uniform.

Games **commence by 4.00pm and conclude by 5.00pm**. Buses will arrive back to the College by 5.30pm for away games and all students are supervised until they leave the College or are collected by parents.

Students are expected to participate in all rounds of competition once selected for their team. Fixtures are posted on the College website and in Daily Notices. Student are required to wear the College sports uniform and appropriate mouth guard (if required for that sport) and footwear for the activity. **Shirts and all other equipment will be distributed by the College where required.**

All students are highly encouraged to participate in a CAS team at the College.
