


Curriculum Overview at Lake Joondalup Baptist College

The Curriculum Office

The Curriculum Office is the centre for enquiries related to subjects, courses, selection of subjects and courses, and strategic planning for the curriculum from Year 7 to Year 12. The Curriculum Office is the location for the Dean of Studies, the Secondary Curriculum Manager and the Executive Assistant for Curriculum.

The Curriculum Office also supports students by offering guidance with organization and study planning with the Secondary Curriculum Manager or the Dean of Studies to help students follow through with study skills being demonstrated in the class regardless of Learning Area. The Dean of Studies and Secondary Curriculum Manager also liaises with the Heads of House to ensure the overall wellbeing of students are catered for all students whilst they are at the College.

The Lower Secondary years are important transition and formative years. LJBC's Lower Secondary curriculum provides students with a strong foundation in the Eight Learning Areas, and maximises student aspirations and academic choice as they progress through the Secondary School.

Some classes, including English and Maths, are streamed according to ability to enhance student learning. LJBC students are encouraged to set realistic goals and to aspire to personal excellence in their studies.

The Arts	Art, Music, Media, Dance and Drama
English	Writing, Reading (including the study of Literature), Viewing, Speaking and Listening
Health & Physical Education	Health, Personal Safety, Fitness, Sports, Human Movement, Management Skills

Christian Education	In Year 9 all students complete The Rite Journey Program

SEQTA Learn is the College Student Learning Gateway. As we are currently living and learning in a digital age, it is important that students learn to harness technology effectively to maximise educational opportunities. SEQTA Learn allows students to access daily homework, review electronic material used in class, see and reflect on course and subject results as each assessment is marked and keep track of all assessment dates. Through SEQTA Learn, students are encouraged to set their personal learning goals for the year and to upload assessments for each subject and course to teachers electronically. There is also space for students to respond to individual subject teacher's electronic feedback on assessments, ensuring that as learners they understand their level of responsibility in the learning process. At the College students are encouraged to communicate frequently with teachers as part of the feedback process so that early misunderstandings in learning may be addressed as quickly as possible.

SEQTA Learn also allows students to view and submit canteen orders, access extra learning resources, participate in set learning programs, access personal email accounts and check daily timetables.
