Definition

Kindergarten 20 students (Maximum Cohort 56)

Pre-Primary 20-26 Students (Maximum Cohort 56)

Year 1 28 Students (Maximum Cohort 56)

Year 2 28 Students (Maximum Cohort 56)

Year 3 30 Students
Year 4 30 Students
Year 5 30 Students
Year 6 30 Students

Class sizes are based on spaces available, Award and EBA negotiations and recognition of the employment of Educational Assistants in classes which allows larger classes than may be set in some comparative schools.

Secondary:

Years 7, 8, 9, 10 32 Students Years 11, 12 25 Students

Class sizes are based Award and EBA negotiations. These sizes are nominal and class sizes may be varied up to 32 in some Learning Areas or, where specified, in practical areas such as T&E, to a maximum of 24.
