



Year 12 Ball Agreement Form For students and their invited guests

All guests attending the Lake Joondalup College Ball need to read the Conditions of Attendance and realise that they must agree to adhere to all the conditions pertaining to this function. If there is an aspect of any requirement to which guests feel they cannot adhere, they should not sign below and may not attend.

Attending the Year 12 College Ball is a privilege. In order to attend, students must be in good standing with the College, cooperate fully with College staff and abide by the conditions outlined in the Student Planner. Students may choose to accompany another student at the College or bring an invited guest

Conditions of Attendance

- Dress is formal.
- Year 12s are allowed to invite outside guests. Outside guests must be approved by the Ball coordinator and Dean of Students.
- Please arrive on time. Introductions commence at 7pm with the Ball being officially opened at 7.20pm.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the venue before the official close at midnight - please ensure transport is organised to leave the venue promptly at midnight.
- A welcoming party will meet students and guests at the entrance to the Ball venue. Please make sure you introduce your guest and greet the welcoming party on entry to the ball room.
- All students and guests are to remain in the ballroom for the duration of the Ball - other parts of the complex are out of bounds.
- In line with College policy as stated in the Student Planner, students (and outside guests) must not bring alcohol, cigarettes, smoking implements or any other drugs to the Ball. Furthermore, any student or guest who arrives at the Ball under the influence of alcohol or other drugs, or who has been smoking prior to the Ball will be refused entry. In the case of LJBC students, they will be sent home in a taxi at the parents' expense. LJBC students will also face further sanctions upon return to the College. If there is some doubt whether or not a student or outside guest has consumed alcohol they may be requested to submit to a breath test administered by a Senior Staff member.
- Stage diving and other dangerous activities are not acceptable and students must immediately comply with any request by staff to cease such activities.
- Outside guests must be at least 15 years of age. They must be prepared to accept all behaviour standards expected of students at this College and to behave as though they are students at this College. Students who have been asked to leave the College may not attend as invited guests.

Outside guests who do not abide by all of these conditions will be removed from the Ball. LJBC students will be sent home in a taxi at parents' expense.
