

**Online Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (OLNA)** 

- 2013 Feedback from employers and training providers about the low literacy and numeracy capabilities of some school leavers
- 2016 minimum standard of literacy and numeracy required to achieve a Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE)



### Background information Online Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (OLNA)

 OLNA has been designed to measure skills identified with those being necessary after a student leaves school





## **OLNA Assessments Details**

The OLNA is comprised of three different assessments Literacy – Reading Literacy – Writing Numeracy

Students will be given login and password details as they enter the assessment room



#### Writing Assessment

Broad topic given to student. 60 Minutes to write, no minimum but limited to 600 words maximum. Students marked on: how well you engage the audience the structure and organisation of your writing the words and language you choose the cohesiveness of your writing your use of correct grammar, punctuation and spelling

- Catch up assessments opportunities will be scheduled for each day following the assessments




# What happens if the minimum requirements are not met?

It is expected that some students will not meet the minimum standard of some or all of the OLNA on their first or even subsequent attempts.

Students can attempt the OLNA a total of six times.

OLNA testing is scheduled to occur every March and September.





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
