### **Year 12 Graduation Evening – Friday 21 October 2022**

It gives me great pleasure to invite you to the Year 12 Graduation Evening, which will be a very special evening for students, family members and staff. The evening is a formal occasion when prizes are awarded, and each Year 12 student receives a College Graduation Certificate and gift. As is our tradition, Year 12 students will wear College academic gowns and graduation sashes with their winter College uniform (the blazer/jumper are not required).

The Graduation Evening will once again be held at the HBF Arena. The evening will begin with a Sundowner at the venue, at which light refreshments will be served to Graduates and their guests from 5.30pm. Graduates will be able to spend time with their guests prior to a final briefing from their Heads of House at 6.10pm.

We will ask all guests to be seated in the main arena by 6.50pm for the formal Graduation Ceremony commencing at 7pm.

Admission to the Graduation Ceremony will be by ticket, and we have up to six complimentary tickets available for each Graduate to invite guests. **Please note: Graduating students will be seated together separately and do not require a ticket.**

We hope your family and friends enjoy this special arrangement from wherever they are in the world.

A professional photographer will be available during the Sundowner event from 5.30pm and after the Graduation Ceremony for family photos. ### Friday 21 October – Graduation Evening

- 5.30pm: Arrive; Photographer available for professional family photos  
Sundowner event commences – canapés and refreshments provided
- By 6pm: Year 12 students arrive in formal winter uniform
- 6.10pm: Year 12 students proceed to the main arena for briefing
- 6.40pm: Main arena open to guests with tickets (*please note there is no allocated seating*)
- 6.50pm: All guests to be seated in the main arena
- 7.00pm: Graduation Evening commences with formal procession of staff and graduating students

After the ceremony the photographer will once again be available in the Basketball Stadium for Graduate/family photos.

## Graduation Uniform Expectations

Please read the following checklist as a reminder of the expected standards for Graduating students.

**Winter uniform** *Note: navy jumper, cardigan and blazer are not compulsory for the evening*

### Boys

Light blue tuck-in shirt, College tie; grey trousers; College socks; standard plain black lace-up school shoes – clean and polished; plain black belt.

### Girls

Light blue over-shirt; College tie; College skirt; navy 40-70 denier tights; standard plain black lace-up school shoes – clean and polished.

### Hair

- natural hair colour, conservative style, well groomed, neat, clean
- blended hair length - no extreme differences in hair length or colour
- hair tied/clipped back, including fringes hanging in face
- hair accessories - plain black, navy, light blue, yellow or gold
- moderate hair products
- minimum of number two haircut (no shaved heads or undercuts)

**Grooming**

- a light cover of foundation is acceptable
- clear lip gloss only
- nails - clear nail polish only
- all boys should be clean shaven
- one piercing on the lower lobe of the ear
- no visible tattoos

**Jewellery**

- one small plain stud or sleeper in the ear lobe
- a watch
