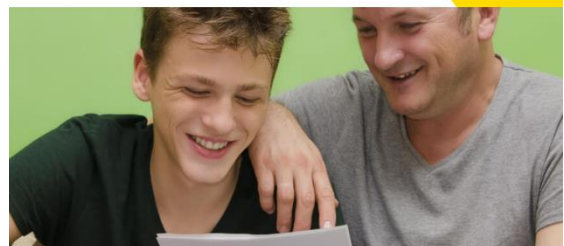



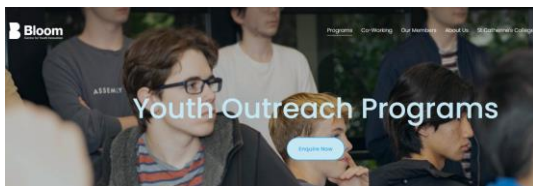
Entrepreneurship for 12 – 17 year old students @Bloom

South Metropolitan TAFE in Western Australia will receive new state-of-the-art training equipment under the state's latest defence industry blueprint that will give it a key role in naval manufacturing.



The [Western Australian Defence Industry Workforce Development Plan 2022-27](#) was launched last week. It sets out the approach to skilling WA's defence industry workforce through collaboration across schools, TAFEs, specialist training providers, universities, and unions.

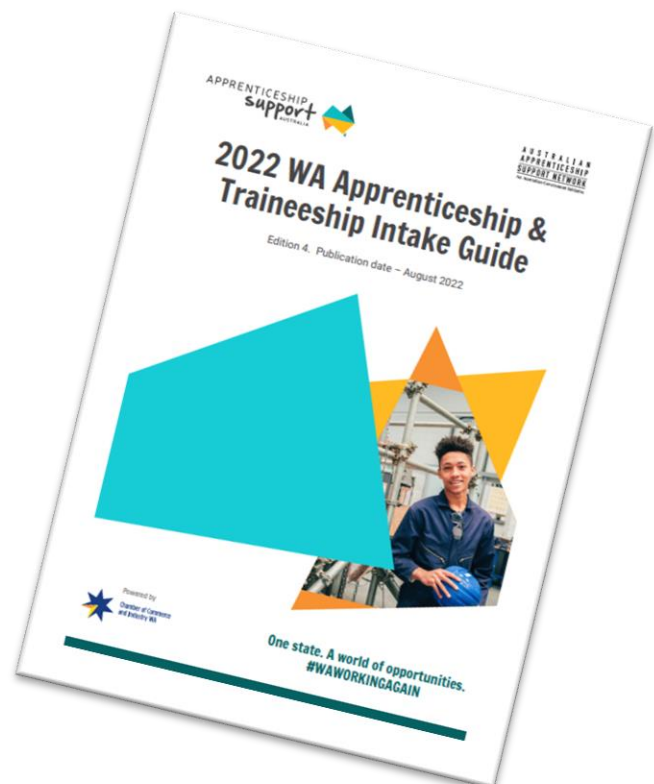

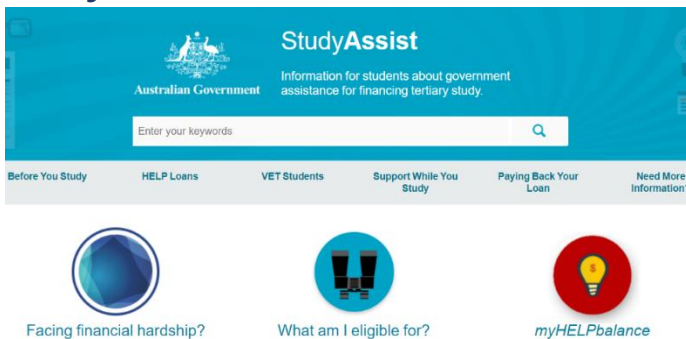
[Letz Live](#) is back. They organise working holidays in educational programs in several countries around the world. Participants are placed as assistants in boarding schools, education camps and programs for young people.

ABSTUDY	<p>Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students and Australian Apprentices.</p>
Education Entry Payment	<p>A yearly payment you get when you start study and get certain income support from us.</p>
Student Start-up Loan	<p>A loan you can get up to twice a year if you're an eligible higher education student.</p>
Rent Assistance .	<p>You may be eligible for Rent Assistance if you are getting ABSTUDY Living Allowance, Austudy or Youth Allowance</p>

ECU Creative Arts Portfolio Entry for School Leavers

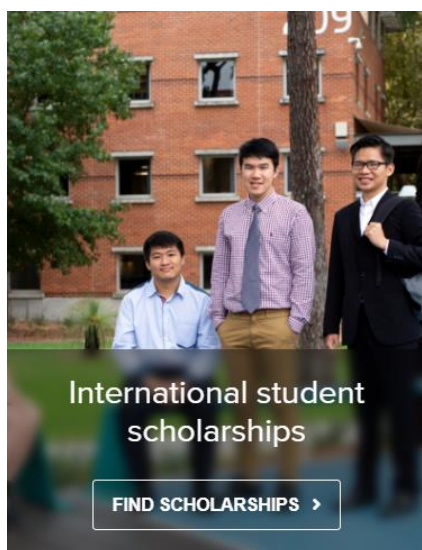
Creative potential cannot always be captured by an ATAR score. ECU's School of Arts and Humanities has developed a new strand of the university's experience-based entry pathway to enable eligible school leavers to gain entry into our Bachelor of Design, Arts, or Media & Communication, in majors such as Photomedia, Screen Production, Visual Arts, Fashion, Visual & Spatial Design or Games and Interactive Design.

Minimum requirements are Year 12 English General minimum grade of A or equivalent, with a minimum of 1 ATAR course and 3 General courses with at least one in an area related to your major. Applicants who can demonstrate the technical and creative potential to be successful through an application including a digital portfolio will be selected for interview with a view to commencing studies in 2022.

As of 2024, Notre Dame's Bachelor of Biomedical Sciences (Fremantle), will enable a guaranteed pathway for a number of specified places into the Doctor of Medicine program, based on the highest ranking through the standard GEMSAS selection.

From 2024 Notre Dame will offer a guaranteed pathway into the Doctor of Medicine for the top Biomedical Science Graduates.

In 2024 there will be 15 places granted based on:

1. Their Grade Point Average in Biomedical Science degree (how good their results are). You can check how the Grade Point Average is calculated for medicine at Notre Dame [HERE](#). In 2022 students commencing Doctor of Medicine had a Grade Point Average of 6.53 (out of a possible 7)
2. Their [GAMSAT](#) (Graduate Medical School Admission Test) results
3. An Interview – These are a series of mini interviews which are rapid fire and stressful.

Pre Medicine Certificate

Notre Dame delivers a [Pre Medicine Certificate](#) that students undertake in addition to their full undergraduate degree. Successful completion of the course guarantees AN INTERVIEW if you meet the required Grade Point Average and GAMSAT requirements. It does not guarantee a place in the Doctor of Medicine course. Students must assess how much doing the Pre Medicine Certificate will impact on their Grade Point Average and GAMSAT scores.

Information Session: Notre Dame will be running its “Getting Into Medicine” Information Session later in the semester. Information about the new Biomedicine Pathway will be included in that presentation which will be available online.

Apprentice Accommodation Allowance from CTF



Get funding assistance when you travel for your off-the-job training.

The Construction Training Fund can provide an accommodation allowance to apprentices and trainees living in regional WA who need to travel to attend scheduled off-the-job training with an RTO. The allowance covers the difference between their rebate from the Department of Training and Workforce Development (DTWD) and their-out-of-pocket expenses for commercial accommodation.

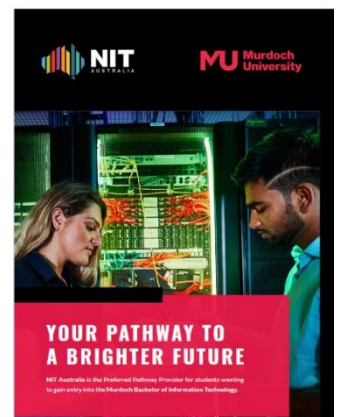

Diploma of IT pathway to Bachelor of IT at Murdoch University

Completion of the Diploma of IT provides skills and qualifications that could lead to jobs while you are doing your degree.

ECU The Portsmouth-Perth Partnership

ECU and the University of Portsmouth have joined together to offer students the opportunity to complete dual degrees by studying at both universities.

How it works

As a student, you can graduate with two separate degrees by enrolling at your home institution for two years of the degree program and then undertaking one year of exchange study at the partner institution. You would then return home to Australia to complete the final semester/year units of the degree at your home institution.

Support for mainstream students with literacy barriers

If you want to do a mainstream VET course but don't have standard literacy skills, there is plenty of support available.

- **Course in Applied Vocational Study Skills. (CAVSS).**

You enrol in your VET course and an expert literacy teacher works in your class with the skills expert (business, upholstery, plumbing, IT) to help those students who need language, literacy and numeracy support.

- **Underpinning Skills for Industry Qualifications (USIQ).** This is a WA program that also provides in class support to ensure that students achieve the competencies stipulated by the course.

When you contact your local [Jobs and Skills Centre](#), let them know that you may want CAVSS or USIQ support.

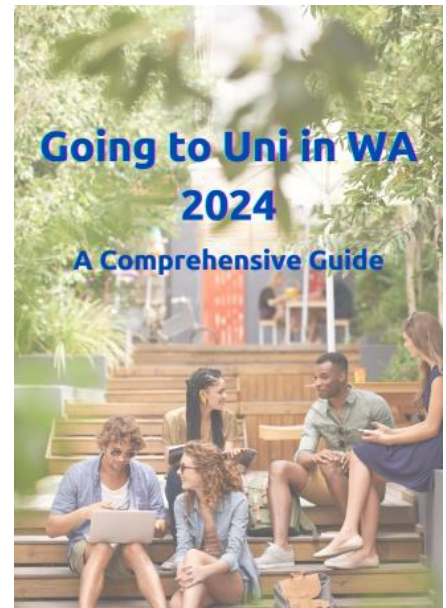

Shortage of Pharmacists

Western Australia is experiencing a shortage of pharmacists.

We have relied on other countries to meet our need for these highly skilled health care professionals and COVID has stopped the flow.

The demand for pharmacists is significant and unlikely to stop even when overseas trained pharmacists return to boost our workforce. You can study pharmacy in Western Australia at:

- [Curtin](#) which has an ATAR entry requirement of 80, and prerequisites include Chemistry and Maths Applications. They would also like you to have Human Biology or Biology, but they aren't essential.
- [UWA](#). This is a post graduate degree. To be considered for a place you must have ATAR Chemistry, Maths Applications or higher and university level microbiology and pharmacology.

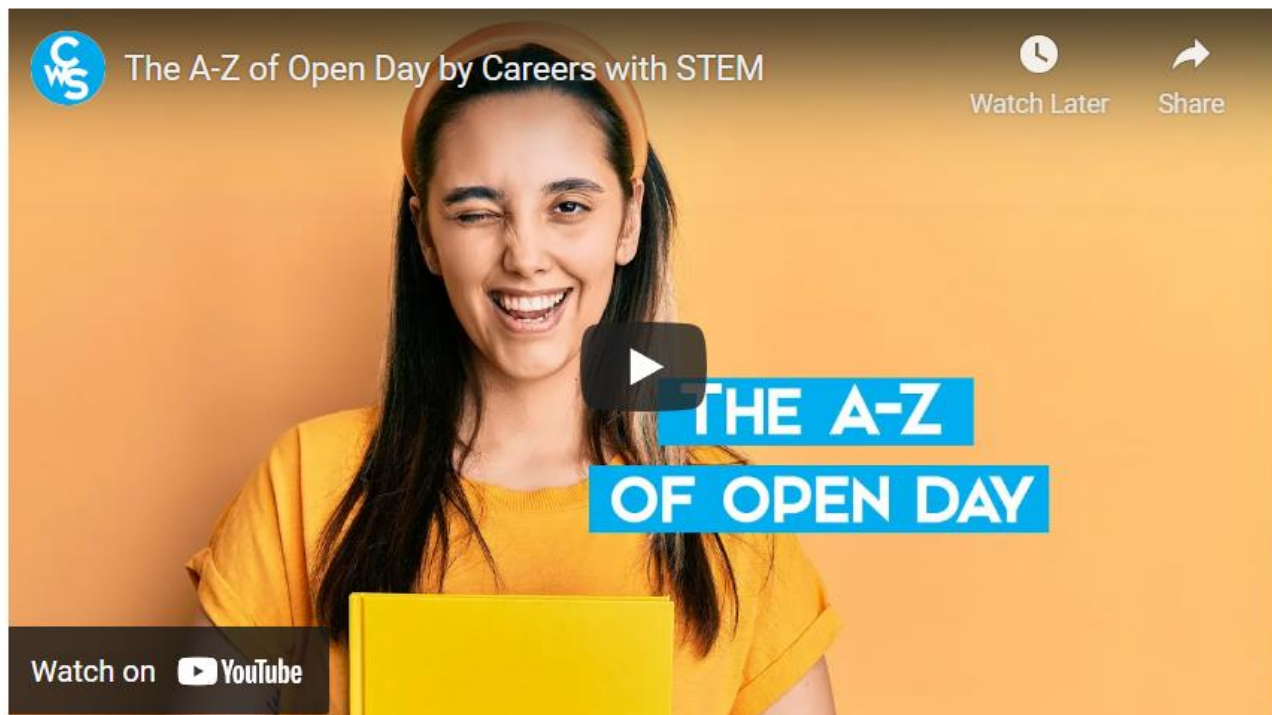

BHP Pilbara Rail Academy Trainees = 70% Women 20% Aboriginal

BHP is planning to employ 200 new train drivers over the next three years.

There is a significant change in the gender balance in the train driver workforce with 70% of the trainees being female. Aboriginal workers are employed across BHP and 20% of the train driver trainees are Aboriginal.

It is a 10-month course and there was strong competition for the traineeships.

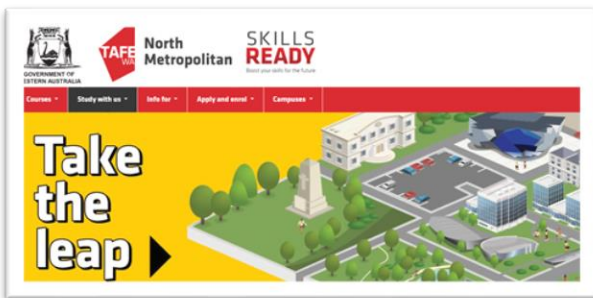

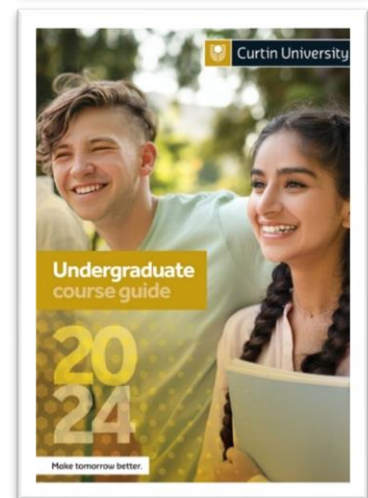

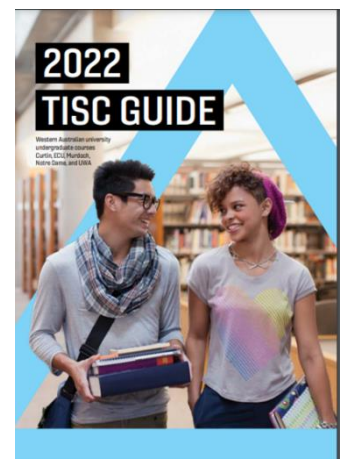

Pathways to VET for those without their WACE or OLNA

The [Online Literacy and Numeracy Assessment](#) (OLNA) is designed to enable students to successfully meet the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) literacy and numeracy requirements.

There are several alternative pathways to TAFE for school students who do not achieve an OLNA:

- **Vocational pathway (VET in schools):** school students who complete a vocational course while at school can rely on their AQF qualification to demonstrate their literacy and numeracy skills (this is included in the guide) i.e. students can achieve an OLNA or a Certificate I, II or III to gain entry to a TAFE course (with the exception of qualifications within the Foundation studies training package (FSK);
- **TAFE Admissions testing:** TAFE Admissions adopted the reading and numeracy modules of the OLNA as its literacy and numeracy testing tool. Subject to verification with the School Curriculum and Standards Authority, school students may be eligible to register for TAFE Admissions testing if they have not sat the OLNA at school within the six months preceding TAFE Admissions testing and if they have not exhausted their maximum six attempts at the OLNA while of compulsory school age;
- **Alternative assessment:** students can be referred to the learning area at their preferred TAFE college for a Learning Area Assessment;
 - Students can enrol at any Certificate I level, as there are no entry and
 - Students can enrol into one of the foundation skills and equity courses.

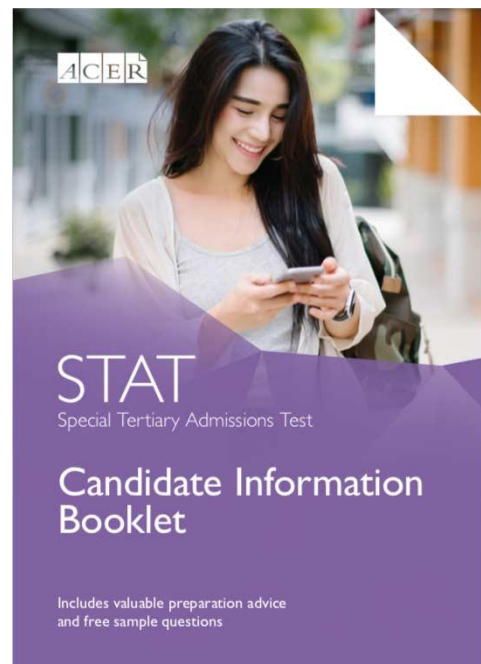
STAT

All students must complete Year 12 with an ATAR or gain entry via the [STAT](#) pathway if not sitting the ATAR.

The Test is managed by ACER.

- ACER do not impose any restrictions on who can sit STAT.
- Universities/course authorities may impose restrictions on who they will accept STAT results from. Candidates should check with the institution to which they are applying to determine if their STAT results will be accepted.
